To Whom It May Concern:

Currently there are no test for efficacy against Human Hepatitis virus. The United States Environmental Protection Agency (US EPA) has allowed surrogate virus testing to support claims for Hepatitis viruses for disinfectants. Also there is no recognized test for efficacy against Human Papilloma virus (HPV). The recently reported test for HPV has not been approved by any government or professional agency. Best Sanitizers is currently investigating the position the Food and Drug Administration Center for Devices and Radiological Health (FDA CDRH) has in regards to the validity of these tests. FDA CDRH regulates High Level Disinfectants and Chemical Sterilants and has different standards for testing than US EPA. Human Hepatitis viruses and HPV are non-enveloped viruses and ACECIDE-C has been proven effective against the following non-enveloped viruses: Polio and Adenovirus.
